We are writing regarding an exciting ski trip which we are organising exclusively for Sixth Form students. The trip is open to all members of the current Years 11 and 12, who will be in Year 12 and 13 respectively by the time the trip takes place. The trip has been booked for the February Half Term 2019, leaving school on Friday, 15th and returning on Saturday 23rd February 2019. I have a provisional booking for 32 students and all those interested should apply as early as possible as places will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

Eligibility

As you will appreciate, this trip if for the next academic year, and as such I must stress that only students who are on the school role at the time of the trip will be eligible to travel. Students who sign up for this trip now, but do not continue with their studies at John Warner next year will not be allowed to come on the trip, and the school cannot guarantee that any money paid will be able to be refunded. We expect continued excellence of behaviour and effort up to and including this trip. However, if students fail to abide by the school rules we reserve the right to take away the privilege of going on this trip. Obviously the school have an excellent reputation on school trips and wish to uphold this tradition.

The Resort

The resort that we have booked is Dachstein West in Austria, which sits in the heart of the Austrian Alps and is a UNESCO Heritage Centre. Accessed via the three surrounding villages of Gosau, Rossbach and Annaberg, Dachstein West is a traditional Austrian resorts offering picturesque tree lined pistes which are ideal for beginners and intermediates. Experienced skiers will also be offered a challenge with over 20km of black runs and 3 freestyle snow parks. The resort offer over 140km of piste, making it one of the largest combined ski areas in Austria. Dachstein West has an excellent snow history, resulting in excellent skiing conditions and thus it is widely regarded as one of Austria's top ski destinations. We will be staying in the nearby town of Bad Ischl which offers a wide range of après ski and evening entertainment options. The Jugendhotel is a newly refurbished three Star accommodation situated near to local amenities and a short drive from the ski slopes.

The Cost

This virtually all-inclusive package will cost £905.00. Skiing holidays are expensive as we have to travel in high season, over the school's half term holiday. This price represents a very competitive offer for an Austrian ski resort in an extensive ski area. The cost will include:

- 1) Executive coach travel from school to resort
- 2) Channel crossing via ferry
- 3) Full board accommodation
- 4) Six days hire of skis, boots, poles and ski helmet
- 5) 6 x 5 hours ski tuition
- 6) Six full days lift pass
- 7) Resort representative service
- 8) Full Medical and Travel Insurance Cover
