Grant criteria

[As extracted from clause 15 of Charity commission scheme]

the trustees..... shall applythe income of the Charity in promoting the education [including social and physical training] of persons under the age of 25 years who or whose parents or guardians reside in the Borough of Broxbourne in the County of Hertfordshire and who are in need of financial assistance, and in particular [but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing]

[a] in awarding to such persons exhibitions tenable at any school, university, college of education or other institution of further [including professional and technical] education approved for the purposes by the Trustees;

[b] in providing financial assistance, outfits, clothing, tools, instruments or books to assist such persons to pursue their education [including the study of music and other arts], to undertake travel in furtherance thereof, and to prepare for and enter a profession, trade, occupation or service on leaving school, university or other educational establishment;

[c] in providing, or in assisting in the provision of, religious instruction in accordance with the Christian religion by means of Sunday Schools or otherwise.

.....the Trustees shall apply the same in like manner for persons under the age of 25 years who or whose parents or guardians reside in the District of East Hertfordshire and who are in need of financial assistance.

The trustees are pleased to consider grant applications in the following circumstances [but not exclusively]:

[a] to enable students to take part in educational events and activities which they might otherwise have been unable to afford;

[b] towards the costs of special projects in Junior Church/ youth activities etc.

[c] to provide support for students for further education, social work and physical training where only limited financial contributions are possible by reason of family circumstances.

Financial Circumstances

i) When considering applications for grants by or on behalf of individuals over the age of 16 years, the Trustees expect the applicant to demonstrate, that he/she is making efforts to raise money from other sources, such as part time work.

ii)The Trustees would also prefer all applicants to offer a contribution rather than requesting the full cost of the activity.

iii)To enable the Trustees to peruse the grant application sympathetically, they request that applicants submit detailed financial outline, to include actual income received weekly or monthly.

iv) Applicants not in full time education will be required to supply a reference, as to the applicant's character and over what period of time known to the referee. Referees should be a Minister of Religion or educational professional.
