

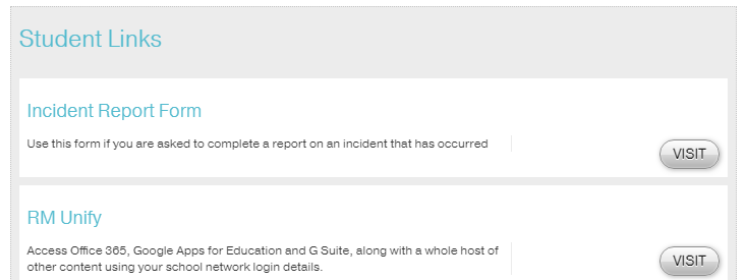
HOW TO CHOOSE YOUR OPTIONS

Links for Students

1. Login to your **internet browser**
2. On The John Warner Website, go to **Portal / Links for Students** and select **R M Unify**. Click the **Visit** button
3. Select the **Mail** icon.
4. Look through your emails. You will see one from noreply@sims.co.uk with the name of **John Warner School The – SIMS Online Service Invite**. Open up this email

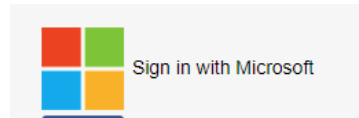

6. Sign in with Microsoft

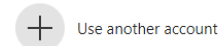
7. Click on your own account or if you can't see your account then choose Use Another Account and enter your school email address (this will be your username@johnwarner.herts.sch.uk)

12. You will now be able to select your option choices. The options will differ depending whether you have been allocated Pathway 1 or Pathway 2; the top of the screen will tell you what pathway you are following:

Learning Pathway 1

This pathway is for students who joined year 7 performing at or above age-related expectations in English and mathematics or whose Cognitive Ability Tests (CATs) show they have the ability to access the curriculum without additional support. Students following this pathway will typically go on to study A Level and level 3 qualifications after completing GCSEs.

- Select 1 from Humanities
- Select 1 from MFL
- Select 2 from Open Choice
- Twilight Optional

Learning Pathway 2

This pathway is for students who joined year 7 performing below age-related expectations in English and mathematics and require additional support to access the curriculum. Students following this pathway will typically go on to study level 3 qualifications (BTEC and A Level) in the sixth form or level 2 qualifications at college after completing GCSEs.

- Select 1 from EBacc
- Select 3 from Open Choice
- Twilight Optional
