Revision sessions will have a specific focus (see below) so pupils can make an informed decision about attendance to sessions.

- **Wednesday 21st February** – Hazardous Earth theory (global circulation, climate change, structure of earth, plate boundaries, volcanoes)
- **Wednesday 28th February** – Hazardous Earth located examples Hurricane Katrina and Typhoon Haiyan (comparison of impacts and management) and also Haiti and Japan (earthquake comparison of impacts and management)
- **Wednesday 7th March** – Development Dynamics (development, globalisation) – including India case study
- **Wednesday 14th March** – Challenges of an urbanising world (megacities, land use, rapid population growth issues) – including Mumbai case study
- **Wednesday 21st March** – UK physical (geology, coasts, rivers)
- **Wednesday 28th March** – Fieldwork overview
